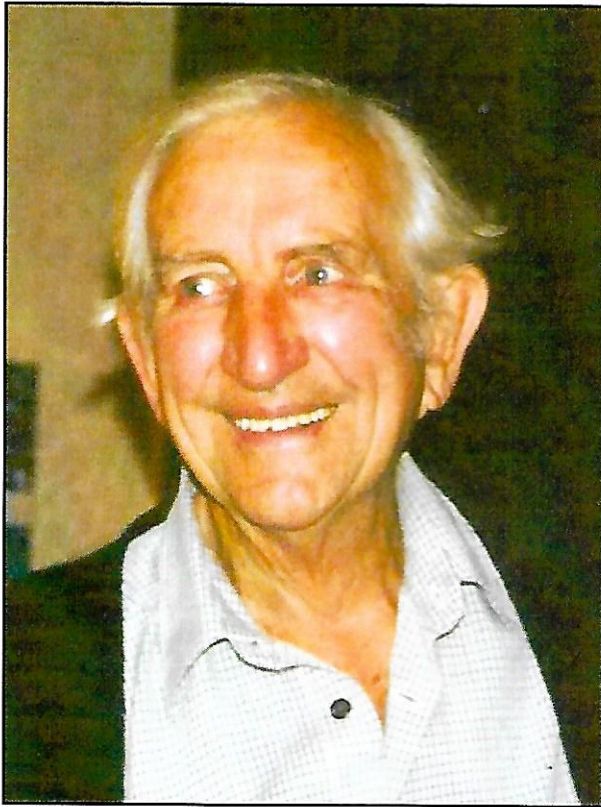

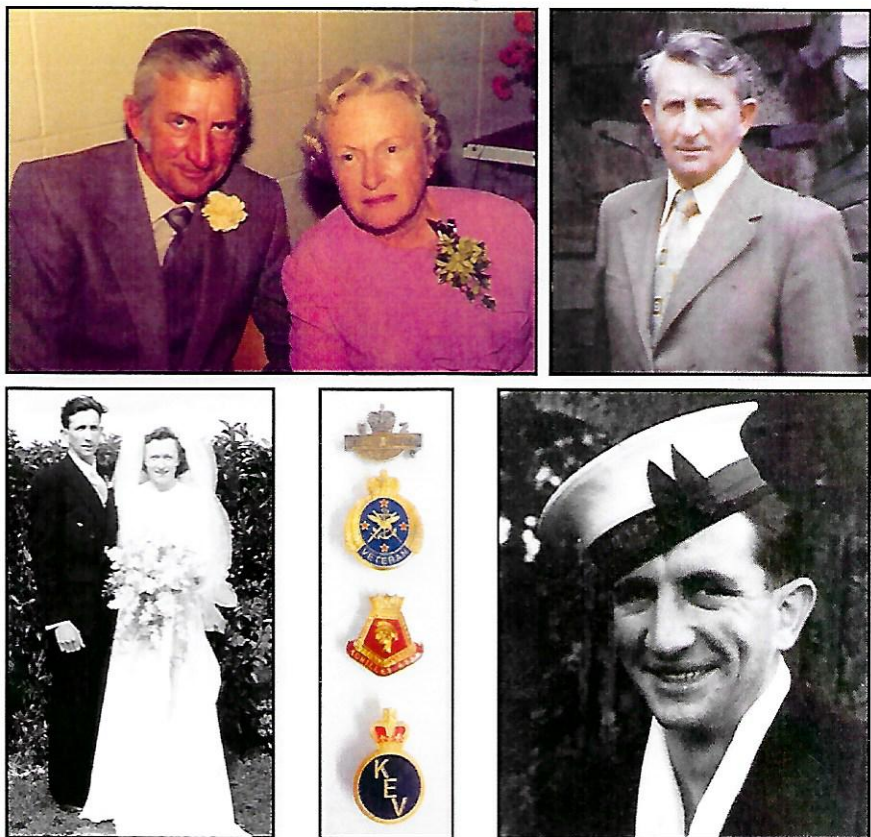
How Great Thou Art
