Hope in God, stand firm and take heart.

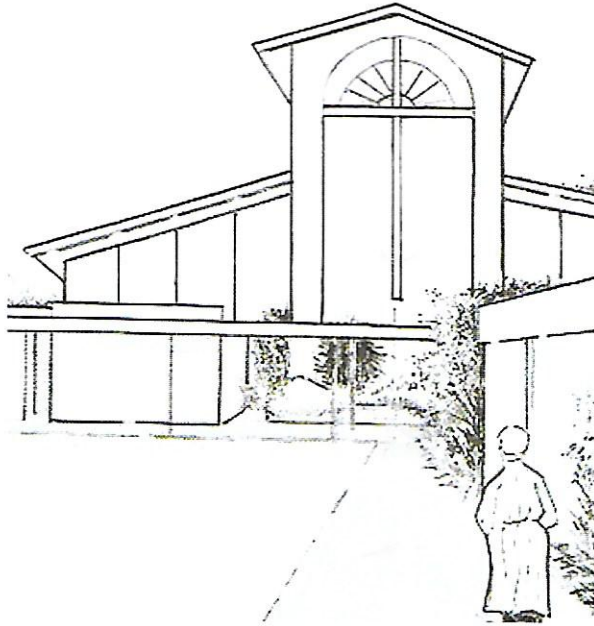
